

PARDOE SPORTSMEN'S ASSOCIATION GENERAL ASSOCIATION RULES

- 1. Association operating hours:
 - a. Indoor Range is 24 hours
 - b. Outdoor Ranges is 9am til sunset. Any exception to be cleared with Board of Directors
- 2. Except for events open to the public, use of Pardoe Sportsmen's Association is restricted to current members, their spouse, and children under the age of 18.
- 3. Current members are encouraged to bring a guest. Members are responsible for the guest. There are limitations to guest visits. Refer to the Bylaws for details.
- 4. Family activities using the Association should be scheduled through the Board of Directors, by mail, not less than fourteen (14) days in advance. Families of more than eight (8) people.
 - a. Family activities are restricted to immediate members of the paid member (i.e. spouse, children, siblings, parents). The Pardoe Sportsmen's Association shall not be held responsible or liable for any injuries sustained while on Association grounds.
 - b. All activities are at your own risk.
- 5. Membership Card MUST be displayed openly while on Pardoe Sportsmen's Association property. Exception made for public events. Anyone failing to produce a membership card must leave the property and can be prosecuted for trespassing.
- 6. Any person using Pardoe Sportsmen's Association property shall be fully and financially responsible for any damage they or their guests inflict upon the property or equipment.
- 7. No member or guest shall conduct themselves in any manner that can cause or causes harm to the health, safety, or general welfare of any person.
- 8. No Alcoholic beverages or Illegal drugs are permitted on Pardoe Sportsmen's Association property.
- Motorized vehicles are only permitted on roadways and designated parking areas; off-road vehicles are prohibited from Pardoe Sportsmen's Association property.
- 10. Littering is prohibited. This includes used ammo and used targets. No glass or cans are permitted as a target.
- 11. Paper Targets will be affixed to target backstops, not backstop frame where applicable. Targets will be positioned in such manner that ALL SHOTS fired will strike the backstop. Side safety berms are NOT backstops and shall not be used as a backstop.
- 12. Any exception to the above rules must be approved by the Board of Directors.
- 13. Refer to Pardoe Sportsmen's Association By-Laws for Range rules.
- 14. All members and guests must sign the Participation of Waiver Liability Form (Form A_08-2011waiv) before Association use.
- 15. Any violation to the By-laws, Policies and Procedures, or above mentioned General Rules will result in the suspension or revocation of the member's membership. There will be no return of paid fees to the member if membership is suspended or revoked.
